

Causes of the death

- Infectious diseases
- Cardiovascular problems

Japan has advanced medical technologies



Severe problems

- Aging
- Regional depopulation

Medical service imbalance due to large territorial extension

Population decline will lead to inter-regional imbalance of medical services

Requirements of "experts" who resolve these medical problems common to both countries
