HISTORY OF ISU







- Founded in **1918**, ISU gave an impulse to the development of higher education in Siberia and Russian Far East
- •1949 the Branch of the Eastern-Siberian Academy of Sciences was established in Irkutsk. Since that time ISU has been the main University to train specialists for regional academic institutes.
- •1990-s new departments and programs opened
- •2000-s modernization and extension of international contacts
- •2014 Eastern-Siberian Academy of Education joined ISU
- •2016 Departments of Eurasian Linguistics University (Irkutsk State Linguistics University) joined ISU
- •2018 Celebration of 100th anniversary since ISU's foundation



- •over 40 grants from national foundations (ex. the Russian Foundation for Basic Research)







GAMMA-RAY OBSERVATORY


- On the base of Tunka-138 array
- Construction started in 2012.






BAIKAL NEUTRINO TELESCOPE

Research of streams of high energy muons and neutrinos in the cosmic rays, search for rare processes and new types of elementary particles, such as magnetic monopoles and massive particles – candidates for the role of dark matter
