


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Start of our work - 2020 year.

Japan-Russia Student Union Regulations (Draft)

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Supplementary Provisions

Chapter 1: General Provisions

Article 1 (Organization and Name)

The Japan-Russia Student Union (hereinafter, "the Union") is a self-governing student body made up of students of member universities of the Association of Japanese and Russian Universities and related parties.

Article 2 (Purpose)

The Union will engage in activities for the following purposes:

- (1) To deepen exchange between Japanese and Russian students;
- (2) To increase the number of students interested in Japanese and Russian culture, science and technology, and research; and
- (3) To serve as a platform for Japanese and Russian students to submit proposals to universities and government agencies, etc.

Article 3 (Location)

The location of the Union in Japan shall be Hokkaido University (Nishi 5 chome, Kita 8 jo, Kita ku, Sapporo City), and the location in Russia shall be Lomonosov Moscow State University (Российская Федерация, Москва, Ленинские горы, д. 1, Московский государственный университет имени М.В.Ломоносова).



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Problems

To indicate main values and principles of our cooperation.

Membership:

- To include students not only from the universities of the Association, but any students of our countries.
- To include postgraduate students, residents, young specialists under the age of 30.
- To create different types of membership: representatives, ordinary students, mentors, volunteers.
- To indicate the general procedure for admission, registration, withdrawal or exclusion from members of JRSU.

Governing Body:

- To increase the number of vice presidents.
- **To make** election for 2 years.
- To define decision-making system.

The implementation of organizational and technical support for the work of the governing bodies of the JRSU (secretariat / headquarters).

The consideration of the issue of funding the organization, budget and provision of resources.



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Proposals

To create interdisciplinary team of 5 to 10 students studying the different specialties:

- a lawyer (specialist in international law and Legal status of Non-Governmental Organizations),
- an economist,
- specialist in Japanese language and culture,
- a sociologist,
- a computer scientist and etc.


To prepare during next 3-4 months detailed drafts of the Charter and other additional basic documents about various procedures.

3rd Section:


- Do you know how to achieve your goals for continuing education in Russia/Japan?

Main outcomes after questionnaire about education








How does the level of education at the university correspond to your ideas about your future profession?
