## Phase 1 Online Lecture



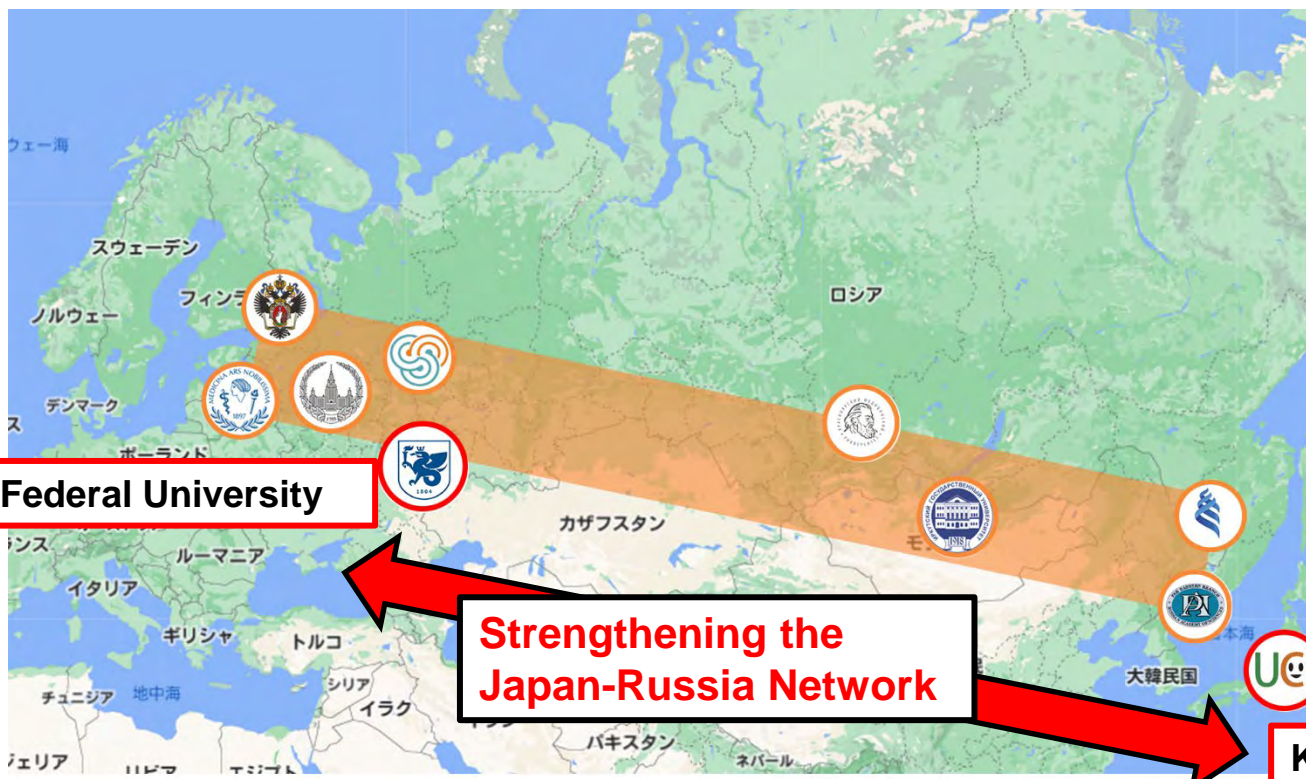
- The lecturer created lecture videos based on themes and topics presented in advance
