INFORMATION LETTER № 2

Dear colleagues!

According to the order of the government of Russian Federation No. 2989-p of December 28, 2018 it is planned to hold an international conference "**Dostoevsky through the Ages and Generations**" devoted to the 200th anniversary of F.M. Dostoevsky at Dostoevsky Omsk State University (OmSU) on **November 11-14, 2021**.

We invite specialists in literature, linguists, historians, ethnographers, art specialists, culture experts and representatives of other sciences to participate.

The purpose of the conference is to study the heritage of F.M. Dostoevsky.

We plan the work of the following sections:

1. Fyodor Dostoevsky and his legacy in the world and Russian culture.
2. Dostoevsky in religious and philosophical thought.
3. Dostoevsky's poetics (narration, genre, style).
4. Unknown pages of the life and work of Fyodor Dostoevsky.
5. Dostoevsky and "the soul of the city". The phenomenon of the Siberian space in the life and work of the writer.
6. Dostoevsky in the educational paradigm.
7. Dostoevsky and Russian linguistic consciousness.
8. "The Diary of a Writer" as a literary and philosophical phenomenon.
9. Dostoevsky and fine arts. The writer as an art critic.
10. Dostoevsky: a view from the future (the youth discussion platform).

Applications in Russian for the participation in the conference will be accepted **until June 18, 2021** by e-mail fmdostocentr@yandex.ru (with the topic "Достоевский в смене эпох и поколений") with the following data: a full name (surname, name and middle/patronymic

name), place of work/study, position, academic title, academic degree; the topic of the report, its theses; contact telephone numbers (including mobile), e-mail and postal address; the need for the technical equipment (screen projector, laptop); the place in the hotel or at the dormitory. Applications in English will be accepted **until September 1, 2021** by e-mail omp.omsu@mail.ru (with the topic "Dostoevsky through the Ages and Generations").

The application must include theses for publication of the collection of conference materials. The organizing committee reserves to select applications without explaining the reasons for their rejections. The conference program will be formed on the basis of selected applications and posted on the website of Dostoevsky Omsk State University until September 29, 2021. As a result of the conference, electronic and traditional paper collections of participants' publications will be published. Articles can be submitted in collections before the conference. All collection materials will be indexed in the RSCI and posted in the scientific electronic library www.elibrary.ru. Following the published collection there will be an opportunity to post selected publications from the collection on the international data base of scientific citation Web of Science Core Collection.

It is planned to organize a cultural program for the guests of the conference.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PREPARATION OF ABSTRACTS

When registering the theses of report please meet the following requirements.

Theses should have the following data in Russian and English:

1. Index of Universal Decimal Classification (UDC).

2. Title of the article.

3. Author(s)'s full name.

4. Place of work/study for each author. It should be official legal name of organization without form of ownership (Federal State Unitary Enterprise, National Research, FSBEI of HPE and etc.) without abbreviation, for example, not "OmSPU" but "Omsk State Pedagogical University". City and country where organization is located. All words of organization name in English language (articles and prepositions excluded) should start with the capital letter.

5. Contact information – e-mail of author(s).

6. Abstract (the title "Abstract" is not required).

7. Key words (expressions) – at least five are recommended.

The number of characters with spaces of abstracts should be max 8000 (approx. four A4 pages).

Text should be typed in MS Word in .doc or .docx format. Font Times New Roman, Size - 14, the interval 1.5, Fields: left 3 cm, right 1.5 cm, top and bottom - 2 cm. Page numbering should be located in the center at the bottom of the page.

Abbreviations should be deciphered in the text and in the abbreviations list at the end of report.

The list of references should be at the end of an article. Links should be in square brackets in the text: with a number in order of mention of work (not by alphabet) with number of quote page. References to sources are page-by-page (included in the text). To make the list of references it is recommended to follow the GOST R 7.0.100-2018 "Bibliographic record. Bibliographic description: general requirements and rules of compilation" (see the samples below).

Requirements for the list of references

The list of references should be at the end of the article. The sources in the list are listed in the order they are mentioned in the text, indicating the total volume of the publication (see the sample above) or the pages of a specific work (if it is an article), for example: *Bocharov S. G. About a conversation around him // Mikhail Mikhailovich Bakhtin / edited by V. L. Makhlina. – Moscow : РОССПЭН, 2010. – Page. 47–79.*

In case of repeated mention in the text of the article of the publication, it is necessary to indicate in square brackets its serial number and pages. The phrases "Decree. op." or "In the same place" are not allowed. Several works cannot be placed under the same number in the list of literature. They should be painted under separate numbers. The phrase "He's/She's" should be replaced by the full name of the author in each specific case.
