Features of fieldwork in Chukotka

- Territory of regulated entry for foreign citizens
- Border zone (partly)
- Local air ticket deficit in the summer time
- Low lodging infrastructure in the villages
- Expensive goods and fuel
 - Difficulties with the delivery of equipment and materials
 - **Unstable weather**

If you preparing to do your research in Chukotka Should plan everything in advance - Better have a Russian coinvestigator -You have to be flexible
